Notes

We observed many large whumpfs and shooting cracks while headed up the meadows of Cinnamon mountain today, several of which were large enough to shake nearby saplings. These collapses were likely triggering on the recently buried layer of basal facets. Conditions included warm temps, light SW winds, overcast to obscured cloud cover, and S-1 to S1 precip including steady [graupe](#)l. Nothing particularly surprising considering the conditions in nearby areas, and we chose to keep our terrain choices conservative.
